Spiritual Message

Aldersgate Sunday

Aldersgate Sunday or Wesley Day is the Sunday preceding to 24th May every year. It is a day that we cherish our methodist tradition in remembrance of our founder John Wesley. It is not solely to remember one man's experience or his work but more so towards God who led John Wesley into evangelical repentance and assurance of salvation.

He famously wrote in his Journal for 24th May 1738:

In the evening, I went very unwillingly to a society in Aldersgate Street, where one was reading Luther's Preface to the Epistle to the Romans. About a quarter before nine, while he was describing the change which God works in the heart through faith in Christ, I felt my heart strangely warmed. I felt I did trust in Christ, Christ alone, for salvation; and an assurance was given me that he had taken away my sins, even mine, and saved me from the law of sin and death.

This experience marks the change of perception regarding his soteriology and also the power of God's grace that provides the assurance of salvation. Ephesians 4:23-24 reminds us : "to be made new in the attitude of your minds; and to put on the new self, created to be like God in true righteousness and holiness."

John Wesley's experience reminds us that justification of faith through Christ needs to continue to be tested because it is the process of sanctification. We will all go through different struggles in life, sometimes it is the doubt, fear and all kinds of distractions in life. May the Holy Spirit continue to remind us that our assurance of salvation is secured in God, and nothing can separate us from the love of God. (Romans 8:38)
