### Life by the Spirit

In his letter to the Galatians, Paul addresses the relationship between Jewish Christians and Gentile Christians in the church, justification through faith, and freedom in Christ. Chapter 5, the final part of the letter, discusses living a life led by the Spirit as part of thefreedom granted in Christ.

Paul uses two contrasting terms—flesh and spirit—to convey his message. He explains that the acts of the flesh are obvious: sexual immorality, impurity, debauchery, idolatry, witchcraft, hatred, discord, jealousy, fits of rage, selfish ambition, dissensions, factions, envy, drunkenness, orgies, and the like. These are all manifestations of the lust of the eyes, the flesh, and the pride of life (1 John 2:16).

In contrast, the fruit of the Spirit includes love, joy, peace, forbearance, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control. These are the results of a spirit-led life. A life guided by the Spirit will produce fruit with attributes reflecting God's nature. By living a meaningful and fulfilling life, we will be able to bless others and honor God.

Therefore, the meaning of salvation is not just about securing our place in heaven; it also involves cultivating the fruit of the Holy Spirit. Living out our lives as a living testimony for those around us allows us to demonstrate that our passions and desires are sanctified, no longer driven by the flesh but by the Spirit. Those who belong to Christ Jesus have crucified the flesh with its passions and desires (Gal. 5:24).
