Spiritual Message



It is easy for us to indulge in certain things. Most indulgence is related to self-centred actions that attach themselves to things such as food, entertainment, and sports. More serious forms of indulgence can develop into addiction—such as drugs, gambling, and pornography. Self-indulgence is closely tied to the self; a person becomes increasingly self-centred and self-focused. It is often a warning stage before someone becomes deeply addicted to certain things.

Proverbs 25:16 tells us, "If you find honey, eat just enough—too much of it, and you will vomit." Moderation, then, is key. We are called to do things—and even to enjoy food and all other things—with moderation. Moderation plays an important role because self-indulgence can lead to dangerous and sinful pursuits of fleshly desires over spiritual obedience. Therefore, moderation is not merely about limiting our actions; through moderation, we practice self-control. This helps us resist temptation and live a godly life that is pleasing to God.

When the Bible speaks about moderation, it differs from how Buddhism approaches it. Buddhism teaches abstinence from all desires, with the goal of reducing craving, which is seen as a major barrier to enlightenment—not as a form of self-punishment, but as a path to liberation. In contrast, the Bible teaches that we are saved by grace through faith, and that our righteousness is an outward—or alien—righteousness given by God, not earned through our own merit. Because of this grace and salvation we have received, we are called to live our lives in response to God's grace, giving Him glory in everything we do. Amen.

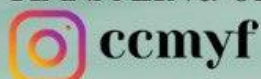
