Intercession

- 1 Prayer for Parents to Receive Wisdom in Raising Their Children:** Thank You for giving us the privilege of bringing forth the next generation. Spiritual Message

Pressing On Toward the Goal

Very often we say, “New year, new resolution.” Normally, when we make New Year’s resolutions, we reflect on the previous year—considering which goals we have accomplished and continuing to work on those that remain unfinished. In fact, Paul mentions in Philippians 3:12 that he himself still had unfinished goals.

12 Not that I have already obtained all this, or have already arrived at my goal, but I press on to take hold of that for which Christ Jesus took hold of me.

13 Brothers and sisters, I do not consider myself yet to have taken hold of it. But one thing I do: Forgetting what is behind and straining toward what is ahead,

14 I press on toward the goal to win the prize for which God has called me heavenward in Christ Jesus. (Philippians 3:12–14)

Paul acknowledged that he had not yet taken hold of his ultimate goal. What, then, was this unfinished task? Verses 10–11 give us insight into what Paul meant:

“10 I want to know Christ—yes, to know the power of his resurrection and participation in his sufferings, becoming like him in his death,

11 and so, somehow, attaining to the resurrection from the dead.”

This reminds us that our mission will not be fully accomplished until the day we see our Lord face to face.

Every day of our lives is a gift of God’s grace—an opportunity to participate in Christ’s sufferings by fully depending on the power of Jesus’ resurrection. We are able to participate in His mission not because of our own merit, but because of His imputed righteousness and His saving grace. Therefore, we must keep pressing forward in every area of our lives, straining toward and pressing on toward the goal, in order to win the prize that comes from above.

May God help us in 2026 to press forward faithfully, accomplishing the responsibilities and areas of work that He has entrusted to us. Amen.


