Intercession

- 1 Prayer for the protests and demonstrations in Iran:** In the midst of extreme oppression and darkness, we ask You to break every power and lie of the enemy, to remove the hardness from the hearts of those in authority, and to restrain them from carrying out more aggressive repression and military retaliation. Have mercy on our brothers and sisters who suffer because of their faith; grant them steadfast faith and supernatural protection.
- 2 Prayer for the blizzard on Russia's Kamchatka Peninsula:** Reportedly affected by powerful polar cyclones and Arctic cold fronts, Russia's Kamchatka Peninsula has recently experienced a historic blizzard not seen in thirty years. Temperatures have plunged to minus 24°C or lower, wind gusts have reached up to 50 meters per second, and snow accumulation has exceeded 12 meters. As extreme weather events continue to intensify worldwide. We pray to the Lord to bring all disasters to an end, to comfort the people in affected areas, and to grant peace and provide for all their needs. We also pray that the Lord would help us cherish resources and work together to protect and care for the natural environment.

Spiritual Message

The Centrality of Our Worship

We are living in a pluralistic society, and at times it is easy to feel lost in such an environment. The Israelites, too, were once accustomed to polytheism. They worshipped many gods, like their Canaanite neighbours—Asherah, Baal, and Dagon. During the pre-exilic period, they worshipped Yahweh while at the same time believing that other gods also existed. It was only after the exile that they came to confess fully that Yahweh is the one true God and that all other gods are false.

In Psalm 115:3–8, the psalmist declares:

“Our God is in heaven;
he does whatever pleases him.
But their idols are silver and gold,
made by human hands.
They have mouths, but cannot speak,
eyes, but cannot see.
They have ears, but cannot hear,
noses, but cannot smell.
They have hands, but cannot feel,
feet, but cannot walk,
nor can they utter a sound with their throats.
Those who make them will be like them,
and so will all who trust in them.”

The psalmist draws a clear distinction between Yahweh and all other gods. Our God is the living and true God who can act and interact with His people, while pagan gods are lifeless, made by human hands. We can pray to our God and come to know His will through the Holy Scriptures, which reveal who He is. Our relationship with Him is relational and covenantal in nature.

Therefore, God alone must be the centre of our worship. May God help us to trust in Him, for all other things ultimately lead to futility. Amen.
