## Spiritual Message

### Grace-Driven Faith

Every day of our lives, we encounter many things—some big, some small. We are constantly faced with decisions, and not all of them are straightforward. At times, we face new challenges—situations we have never encountered before. In such moments, the author of Hebrews reminds us of the importance of faith:

“And without faith it is impossible to please Him, for whoever would draw near to God must believe that He exists and that He rewards those who seek Him.”  
(Hebrews 11:6)

We cannot see faith, yet it is essential for pleasing God. We need faith in order to believe in Him and to draw near to Him. However, when we speak of faith, we sometimes fall into the misconception that it is self-generated or human-centered. In reality, our faith is under the sovereignty of God—it is grace-driven. Because of His saving grace, we are able to respond to Him and be saved.

Not only do we believe in His existence, but through His grace we are also able to draw near to Him. God delights in those who seek Him and draws them closer to Himself. He rewards those who earnestly seek Him. What a great privilege it is to be called sons and daughters of God.

He invites us to seek Him not only at the moment we first receive Him into our lives, but every single day thereafter. We can continually rely on Him. His saving grace leads us to repentance, and His sanctifying grace continues to draw us closer, inviting us to find refuge in Him in the challenging days of our lives.

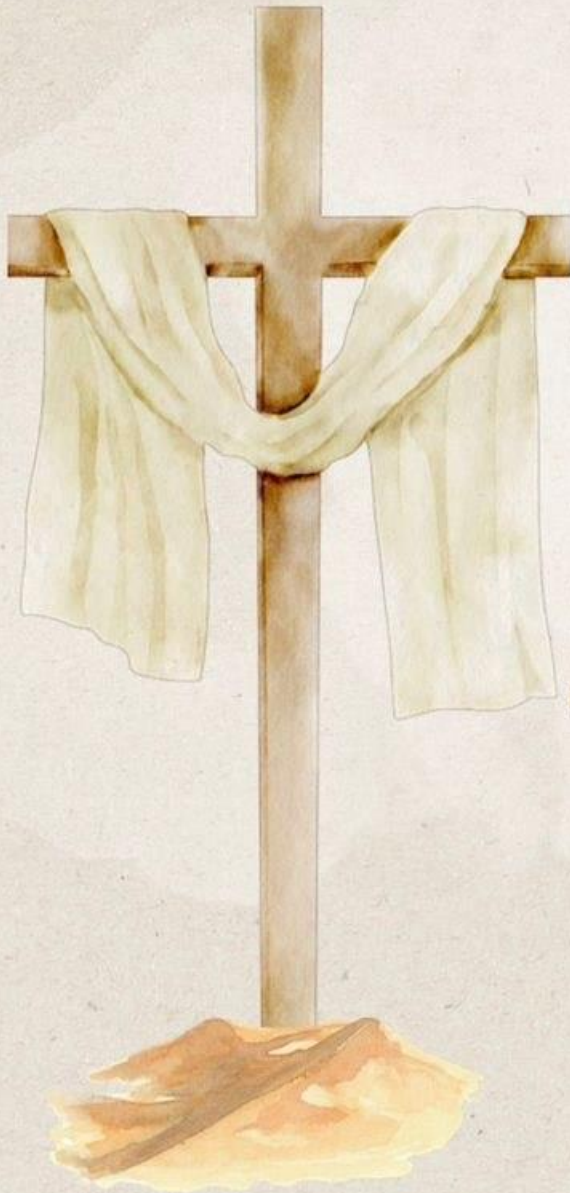
