Intercession

- 1 Prayer for the protests and demonstrations in Iran:** In the midst of extreme oppression and darkness, we ask You to break every power and lie of the enemy, to remove the hardness from the hearts of those in authority, and to restrain them from carrying out more aggressive repression and military retaliation. Spiritual Message

Discipleship within Fellowship Groups

Sometimes we may wonder why fellowship groups are necessary. Isn't it enough just to attend Sunday service to worship God, and then have some fellowship with brothers and sisters afterward?

When we look at the life of Jesus, however, we see that after He was tempted in the wilderness, the first phase of His ministry involved teaching and preaching. Following this, He called disciples to follow Him.

“These are the twelve he appointed: Simon (to whom he gave the name Peter); James son of Zebedee and his brother John (to them he gave the name Boanerges, which means ‘sons of thunder’); Andrew, Philip, Bartholomew, Matthew, Thomas, James son of Alphaeus, Thaddaeus, Simon the Zealot and Judas Iscariot, who betrayed him.” (Mark 3:16–19)

In fact, verse 14–15 explains Jesus' intention clearly:

“He appointed twelve that they might be with him and that he might send them out to preach and to have authority to drive out demons.”

(Mark 3:14–15)

Discipleship happened within a small-group context. Jesus taught His disciples about the kingdom of God, equipped them, and then sent them out to preach the Good News and exercise spiritual authority.

Therefore, it is important that we intentionally consecrate time for fellowship groups. They are not only for bonding and connecting with other brothers and sisters, but also serve as a space where we encourage and edify one another, continue to be equipped, testify for God, and participate in spreading the gospel.
